Pricing Options for Individual Clients* – Spring Term 2026

Option 1: PAY AS YOU GO

Fixed Slot (£66 at W14 9HE / Online or £88 at Client's premises¹)

Description	Who is it for?
<p>This is a rate for one weekly session of up to 2 hours on a dedicated day and time slot² during the period between 5th January and 29th March.</p> <p>The cancellation fee for all unused slots between your start date and 29th March is 50% of the full amount. A deposit of £165/£220 respectively needs to be paid upfront towards it.</p> <p>The tuition charges must be received on the day tuition is due to take place at the latest.</p>	<p>Students who missed the beginning of term start, but can commit to regular tuition for the rest of the academic term.</p> <p>Students who may occasionally need to miss their dedicated weekly session, or temporarily pause tuition, but would like to keep the slot³.</p> <p>Students who start early, but may choose to discontinue tuition after exams.</p>
Advantages	Disadvantages
<p>The best value for money if you have missed or may need to skip some sessions in the future.</p> <p>A dedicated weekly slot guaranteed³ - peace of mind and no need to hunt for available slots.</p> <p>You can book extra slots⁴ at the same price.</p> <p>You can switch to the Membership Plan (Option 2) for your selected slot once your total payments have reached the respective price cap in Option 2 plus £75 (admin fee).</p>	<p>You need to commit to a regular weekly time slot which in general is not changeable (except for very special circumstances).</p> <p>Higher price than the Membership Plan and a 50% cancellation fee for all unused sessions.</p> <p>You may only occasionally (in special circumstances) be able to work back a missed lesson at a different day / time⁴, but availability is not guaranteed.</p>

Option 2: MEMBERSHIP

Fixed Slot (£690 at W14 9HE / Online or £900 at Client's premises¹)

Description	Who is it for?
<p>This is a flat termly fee for one weekly session of up to 2 hours on a dedicated day and time slot² covering up to 12 weeks between 5th January and 29th March.</p> <p>The whole amount can be paid up front with a 5% discount or w/o a discount in weekly instalments of £115/£150 respectively for the first 6 weeks of service until the full amount has been received.</p>	<p>Students looking to start early and commit to regular tuition throughout the academic term for the best outcomes.</p> <p>Students able to commit to a dedicated weekly slot.</p>
Advantages	Disadvantages
<p>Subscription offers the best value for money even if you miss some sessions due to illness or travelling.</p> <p>The biggest impact and best long-term results.</p> <p>A dedicated weekly slot guaranteed³ - peace of mind and no need to hunt for available slots.</p> <p>You can book extra slots⁴ (as per Option 4 below). Once the full amount of your regular membership fee has been received, all extra bookings will be discounted by 30% and paid back to you.</p>	<p>You need to commit to a regular weekly time slot which in general is not changeable (except for very special circumstances).</p> <p>Missed classes are non-refundable.</p> <p>You may only occasionally (in special circumstances) be able to work back a missed lesson at a different day / time⁴, but availability is not guaranteed.</p>

Option 3: BUNDLES

Packs of 5/10 sessions (£345/£645 at W14 9HE / Online or £460/£860 at Client's premises¹)

Description	Who is it for?
<p>This is a rate for a bundle of 5/10 sessions of up to 2 hours on pre-booked and pre-paid slots² anytime⁴.</p> <p>Your sessions are confirmed only once the full payment has been received.</p> <p>Subsequently, the cancellation fee is 50% of the full value of all unused slots.</p>	<p>Students who are unable to commit to long-term tuition or a same-time slot and would like to create a personal schedule.</p> <p>Students who are yet unsure whether they will be able to commit to regular tuition but wish to secure a series of slots.</p> <p>Students who may only temporarily need extra support for a fixed period, e.g., in the run-up to exams.</p>
Advantages	Disadvantages
<p>Individually scheduled slots guaranteed³ - peace of mind and no need to hunt for available slots.</p> <p>You can book extra slots⁴ outside of your bespoke schedule at the same average rate per session.</p> <p>The best option for those with a varied but predictable diary who require a tailor-made schedule.</p>	<p>Higher price than the Membership Plan and a 50% cancellation fee for all unused sessions.</p> <p>You need to commit to your prepaid custom schedule which in general is unmodifiable (except for very special circumstances).</p> <p>Distant future availability of some slots may not be known at the time of booking and you will need to choose them later⁴.</p>

Option 4: BOOK AS YOU GO

Flexible Slot 1 or 2 hrs (£45 or £70 at W14 9HE / Online or £60 or £95 at Client's premises¹)

Description	Who is it for?
<p>These are rates for a single session of 1 or 2 hours respectively on any available time slot² anytime⁴.</p> <p>Your session is confirmed only once the payment has been received.</p> <p>Subsequently, the cancellation fee is 50% of the full amount if cancelled between 48 and 24 hours before the lesson is due or 80% of the full amount if cancelled less than 24 hours before the lesson is due.</p>	<p>Students who are unable to commit to a fixed time slot and would like the flexibility of booking as they go.</p> <p>Students who start very late in the term or are yet unsure whether they will be able to commit to regular tuition.</p> <p>Students who may frequently need to miss or pause tuition.</p> <p>Students who may only temporarily or occasionally need extra support, e.g. in the run-up to exams and will not continue afterwards.</p>
Advantages	Disadvantages
<p>Flexibility of booking as and when needed⁴.</p> <p>The best option for those with busy and unpredictable lifestyles.</p>	<p>Availability is not guaranteed and you will have to choose from currently available slots.</p> <p>Higher price than in all other plans.</p> <p>Any lack of continuity and regularity hinders progress and adversely affects results.</p>
